

# Lots of Hearts

25" x 16"



5. Remove the paper backing from the hearts and arrange on the background piece. Iron hearts to background.
6. Stitch around the hearts using a blanket stitch or zig zag stitch.
7. Pin Baste and layer the quilt top, batting and back. [Diagram 4]
8. Quilt.
9. Stitch around the outside of the quilt through all the layers. The stitching line should be a little less than  $\frac{1}{4}$ " so it doesn't show when the binding is sewn on. Trim excess batting and back even with the quilt top.
10. Bind.

## Supplies:

White Background - 20" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Border - Sides - (2) 20" x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Strips, Top and Bottom  
(2) 17" x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Strips

Back - 27" x 18"

Batting - 27" x 18"

Binding - (3) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " by width of fabric

Hearts - 5 or 6 pieces 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fusible web such as Stream a Seam™

## Directions:

1. Place the side borders on the background fabric, right sides together. Pin. Stitch the borders to the background using  $\frac{1}{4}$ " inch seam allowance. Press seam towards border. [Diagram 1] Repeat for top and bottom borders. [Diagram 2]
2. Trace hearts on paper side of fusible web. Cut out hearts leaving about  $\frac{1}{8}$ " around the outside of the line.
3. Iron the glue side of the fusible to the wrong side of the heart fabrics.
4. Cut out the fabric hearts on the traced line.

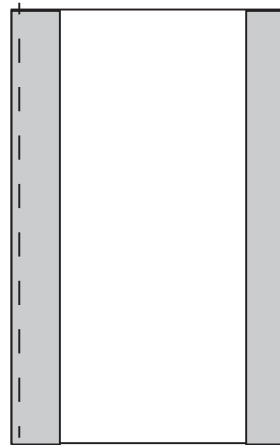

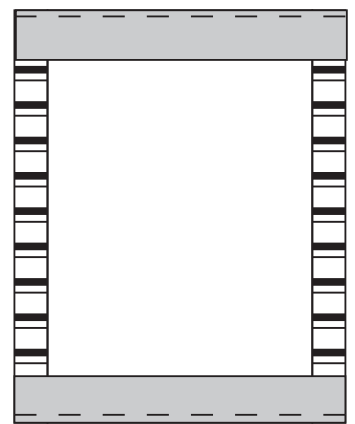

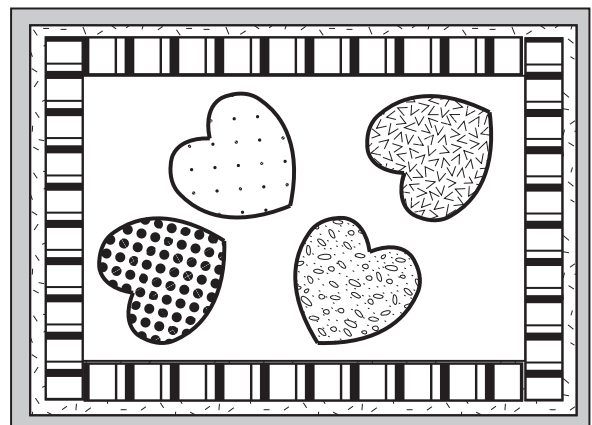
