## Fabric:

Assorted $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Jelly Roll Strips cut into (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $71 / 2 " \mathrm{x} 2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $9 \times 2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $11^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $13 \times 2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $15 \times 2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, (1) $17 \times 2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (Note: Each $\log$ color is two different sizes.)
Center Charm-51/2" x $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Lining for Quilting 13" x 13" Square Pillow Back - (2) $10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ pieces
Binding (optional) - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 50^{\prime \prime}$
Pillow Form

## Sewing Instructions:

- Assemble Log Cabin Block. Sew right sides $5 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to Charm center using $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. [Diagram 1] Press each seam after sewing. Sew $7 \times 2^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top. [Diagram 2] Sew $7 \times 2^{1 / 2}$ " strip to right side. [Diagram 3] Sew $9 \times 2 \frac{112}{2}$ strip to bottom. [Diagram 4] Sew $9 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strip to left side. [Diagram 5] Sew $11 \times 21 / 2$ " strip to top. [Diagram 6] Sew $11 \times 2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strip to right side. [Diagram 7] Sew $13 \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip to bottom. [Diagram 8] Sew $13 \times 21 / 2$ " strip to left side. [Diagram 9] Sew $15 \times 21 / 2$ " strip to top. [Diagram 10] Sew $15 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to
right side. [Diagram 11] Sew $17 \times 2122^{\prime \prime}$ strip to bottom. [Diagram 12]
- Quilt Log Cabin Block - Layer lining, batting and Log Cabin block. Pinbaste. Stitch in the ditch and add free motion quilting to center block and strips. (See Photo for ideas.)
- Assemble Pillow - Finish pillow back $101 / 2$ " overlap edge by turning edge under $1 / 4$ ", press and turn again $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Press. Stitch. Repeat for second back piece. [Diagram 14] Overlap (2) pillow back pieces. [Diagram 15]
- Option 1 - Place Log Cabin top and pillow back wrong sides together [Diagram 15] and bind as if finishing a quilt. Sew the binding to the back with $1 / 4$ " seam allowance, turn and top stitch on the front. [Diagram 15] Insert pillow form.
- Option 2 - Place Log Cabin top and pillow back right sides together. Sew $1 / 4$ " seam allowance around the outside edges. Turn right sides out. Insert pillow form.
