
nal lines. Notice two rectangles can be quilted diagonally. (Diagram 12)
9. Trim the batting and lining even with the nine patch.
10. Place the nine patch, batting, and back pieces together. Pin. Stitch around the pillow leaving a 5 " opening. (Diagram 13)
11. Turn pillow right side out.
12. Stuff pillow through opening.
13. Fold seam allowances to inside on opening. Pin. Stitch opening closed by hand.

## Supplies:

(9) Nine 5" x 5 " Squares (Charms)
(1) 15 " square batting
(1) 15 " square lining for quilting
(1) $14^{\prime \prime}$ Square for Back

## Thread

## Directions:

1. Choose 9 patch layout. (Diagram 1)
2. Place column B pieces on top of column A pieces right sides together. (Diagram 2)
3. Stitch $1 / 4$ " from edge (guide by edge of machine foot). Stitch Row 1 pieces together and then stitch Row 2 and Row 3. Keep stitching to chain the column together. (Diagram 3) Press seams opposite directions. (Diagram 4)
4. Place column $C$ pieces on top of column $B$ pieces right sides together. (Diagram 5)
5. Stitch $1 / 4$ " from edge chaining the column together. (Diagram 6) Press opposite directions. (Diagram 7)
6. Place row 1 over row 2 right sides together. Match seams and pin. Stitch $1 / 4$ " from edge. Press seam down. (Diagram 8)
7. Place row 3 over row 2 right sides together. Match seams and pin. Stitch $1 / 4 /$ from edge. (Diagram 9) Press seam down. (Diagram 10)
8. Layer nine patch right side up, batting and lining. (Diagram 11) Quilt the horizontal and vertical seams in the ditch. Quilt the diago-
