## Fabric Requirements

16" Traditional Blocks
13/4 Yards Background
Binding
Back

## Cutting Instructions

Background Fabric

- Cut (2) $24^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ squares - Sub cut diagonally twice for a total of (8) quarter square triangles [Diagram 1]. You will only use 6.
- Cut (2) $16^{1 / 2}$ " $\times 16^{1 / 2}$ " squares [Diagram 1].
- Cut (2) $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares - Sub cut diagonally once for a total of (4) half square triangles
[Diagram 1].


## Assembly

Sew triangles and blocks together in rows attaching corner pieces as shown [Diagram 2].
Sew rows together [Diagram 3].
Quilt - See quilting suggestions.
Bind - Cut $241^{\prime \prime}$ of binding $1^{11 / 4}$ " or $2^{1 / 2}$ " wide ( $6^{1 / 2}$ strips width of fabric or cut on bias).
Note: The triangles measure larger than needed.
The outside edge can be trimmed down after the quilt is assembled. Since the blocks are printed the measurement may be slightly larger or smaller than $16 "$. Adjust the offsetting block measurement as needed.
