## Fabric Requirements

(3) 16" Traditional Blocks

3/4 Yard Background
Binding
Back

## Cutting Instructions

Background Fabric

- Cut (1) $24^{\prime \prime}$ x $24^{\prime \prime}$ square - Sub cut diagonally twice for a total of (4) quarter square triangles [Diagram 1].
- Cut (2) $12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2}$ " squares - Sub cut diagonally once for a total of (4) half square triangles [Diagram 1].


## Assembly

Sew triangles and blocks together in rows attaching corner pieces as shown [Diagram 2].
Sew rows together [Diagram 3].

Quilt - See quilting suggestions on page 2.
Bind - Cut 241 " of binding $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide ( $6^{1 / 2}$ strips width of fabric or cut on bias).
Note: The triangles measure larger than needed. The outside edge can be trimmed down after the quilt is assembled.
