Fabric Requirements

(3) 16" Traditional Blocks

$\frac{3}{4}$ Yard Background

Binding

Back

Cutting Instructions

Background Fabric

- Cut (1) 24" x 24" square - Sub cut diagonally twice for a total of (4) quarter square triangles [Diagram 1].
- Cut (2) 12½" x 12½" squares - Sub cut diagonally once for a total of (4) half square triangles [Diagram 1].

Assembly

Sew triangles and blocks together in rows attaching corner pieces as shown [Diagram 2].

Sew rows together [Diagram 3].

Quilt - See quilting suggestions on page 2.

Bind - Cut 241" of binding 2½" wide (6½ strips width of fabric or cut on bias).

Note: The triangles measure larger than needed. The outside edge can be trimmed down after the quilt is assembled.

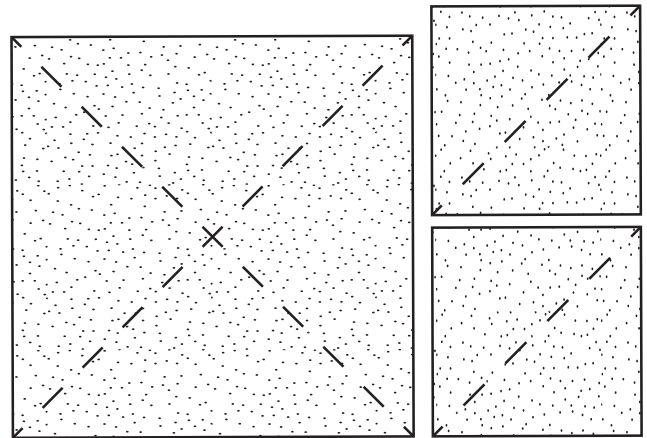

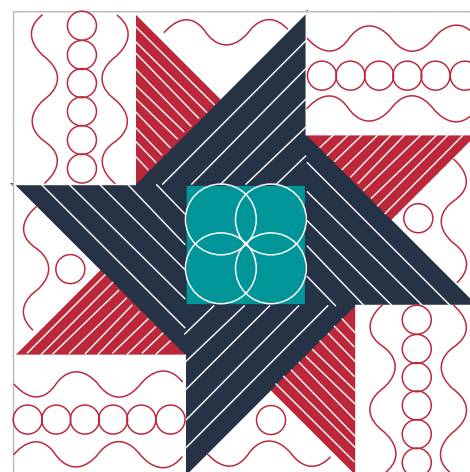
Quilting Ideas: The rulers I used to quilt the blocks are Quilters Rule Nesting Circles Set, Quilters Groove Pro Mini which are both available on rgadesignquilts.com. I used a curvy ruler for Hope of Hartford background. The number and sizes of lines and circles on these idea blocks are not always what I quilted on the sampler. 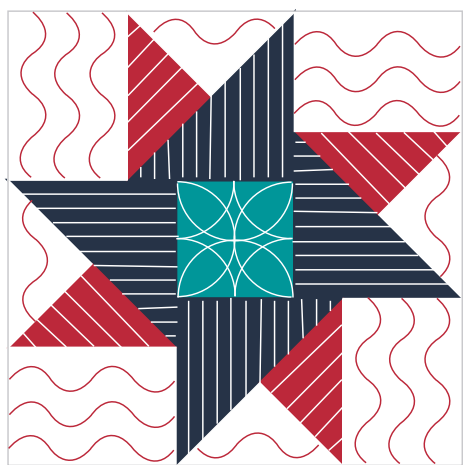

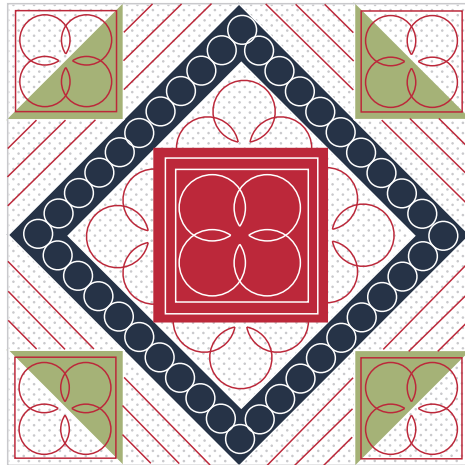

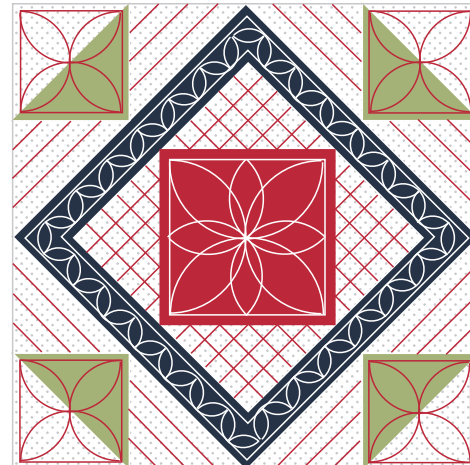
Hope of Hartford - 1
